Golden varieties like Nam Dok Mai and Nam Dok Mai No. 4 are prized for their fragrant sweetness when fully ripe, while Keaw Sawoey and Rad are beloved eaten green, offering a crisp texture and nutty-sweet tang that's uniquely Thai.
